

# BFKN Files Additional Amicus Brief for The American Association of Bank Directors

BFKN attorneys **Robert D. Nachman**, **W. Scott Porterfield**, **John M. Geiringer**, and **Caroline Sear Rummans** recently filed an amicus brief, for rehearing *en banc* or panel rehearing, in the federal Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals on behalf of The American Association of Bank Directors (AABD). The case, *Calcutt v. FDIC*, regarding which BFKN filed an amicus brief at the previous appellate stage, involved enforcement actions taken by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) against someone who has served as a bank director and officer. The amicus brief questioned the procedural and substantive decisions made by the FDIC in the case, and expressed concerns that such decisions would improperly elevate the personal liability and reputation risks of all bank directors. John Geiringer serves on the AABD's Task Force on Mitigating Director Liability.
